Worship Leader—Rev. Cecelia D. Armstrong is called "CeCe" by friends and family members. She has never met a stranger & continues to collect friends, throughout her Christian journey through life and real-world experiences. So, if you are privileged to read this brief biographical sketch, then consider yourself a part of her collection of friends and family members. Pastor CeCe was born and raised in Detroit, Michigan. She was baptized at Calvary Presbyterian Church (USA) and remained a very active member there until her decision to make Georgia her home. Remaining active with the Presbyterian Church through her days spent at Spelman College, Pastor CeCe attended, and eventually joined, New Life Presbyterian Church (USA) keeping membership through 1997. After earning her Master of Education and accepting a position as a high school mathematics teacher near Augusta, Georgia, Pastor CeCe became a member of Belle-Terrace Presbyterian Church (USA). While there, she was ordained as a Deacon, and then an Elder, before she accepted the call on her life into ministry. Pastor CeCe is a graduate of the Interdenominational Theological Center, where she attended Johnson C. Smith Theological Seminary and earned her Master of Divinity. After seminary, she served Grady Memorial Hospital as a chaplain and Beth Salem Presbyterian Church (USA) as supply pastor. As an ordained Minister of the Word and Sacraments in the Presbyterian Church (USA), Rev. Armstrong served as Solo Pastor of Grace Presbyterian Church (USA) in Lantana, Florida and now is the very proud Associate Pastor of St. James Presbyterian Church (USA) on James Island in Charleston, SC. She is currently enrolled at the University of Dubuque Theological Seminary pursing a Doctorate of Ministry. Other notable nuggets about Rev. Armstrong include preaching for the Montreat Youth Conference in 2018, 2020, and 2022, preaching at the Presbyterian Triennium 2019 and in 2022, and preaching at both the Arts, Recreation, and Worship Conference and the Presbyterian Association of Musicians Worship and Music Conference in 2021. She is the Co-Moderator for the National Association of Presbyterian Clergywomen and the Board Chairperson for the Johnson C. Smith Theological Seminary Board of Trustees.
